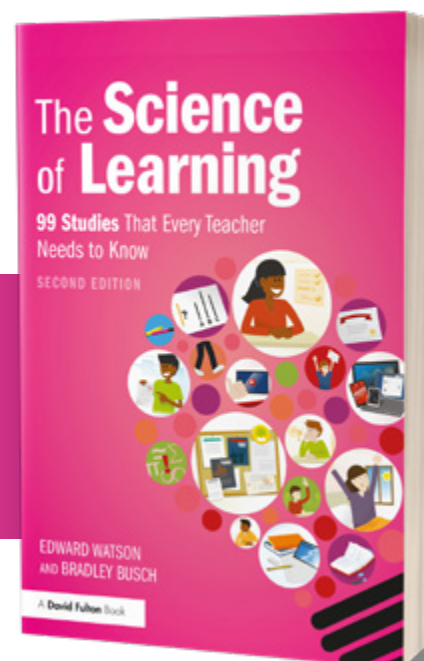


Use *The Science of Learning: 99 Studies That Every Teacher Needs to Know* as a CPD tool.

## 10 book club questions to use with **The Science of Learning**



1. Which study **stood out the most to you**, and why?
2. Which study **surprised you the most**, and why?
3. The book highlights studies that discuss learning strategies such as retrieval practice, spacing and interleaving. **How can you apply this to your practice?**
4. A few studies talk about how to develop resilience, with one looking at the importance of creating a high challenge and high support environment. **What does that look like on a day-to-day basis** for you?
5. A recurring theme of the book is the importance of creating a culture of high expectations. **How can you convey your high expectations** clearly and consistently to students?
6. Several studies touch on the use of technology – mobile phones, tablets and laptops. **What are the pros and cons for the use of technology?** How do they fit into our school policy towards learning and behaviour?
7. Which **study on thinking biases** stood out to you, and why?
8. Several studies highlight what parents can do to help. Which one stood out the most for you? Also, **which study do you think parents would benefit from hearing about** the most?
9. Which **strategy or finding do you already use regularly** that the book has reaffirmed to you as best practice?
10. **What are you going to do differently** as a result of reading the book?
